We need 60 turkeys (cooked or uncooked, 300 pounds of pinto beans, hot chocolate, paper goods. We already have a large donation of rice. Many volunteers and cash donations are appreciated.

THE STORY: Tammy is encouraging the churches to share in the community the resource: **The Story**. This is the Bible in narrative. This would start January 8 and go through the first week in August. The book, **The Story** will be on sale November 25, December 17, 26, and 27 for \$5.00. Tammy will be doing an email to remind.
