1. Mindy Watson, for the **Youth Success Program** of **United Way** - presented data which show that in Curry County 34% of youth skipped school because of safety concerns (NM average is 10%), 11.8% seriously considered suicide, 9.4% planned suicide, 2.6% attempted suicide. 79.9% are economically disadvantaged. The Youth Success Task Force set goals and objectives and are working to increase high quality afterschool and in-school programs, increase access to Mental Health and Substance Abuse programs, and to increase family engagement. There are opportunities for us to join work groups focusing on various needs which have been identified in the community.
