Guest Presentation : *Shawna Russell* (Clovis Municipal Schools). The local Elections are coming up in 2 weeks' time, and there will be a ballot for a General Obligation Bond for the School system. The GO Bond is for ten million dollars. If the GO Bond passes, the State will add a contribution; if the Bond does not pass, the State will not send any money. So it is important to vote for the GO Bond. The money raised will be used for repair and maintenance of classrooms, extra portable classrooms, supplies of laptops for students, repair to the parking lots, increased security. If people are concerned about the security of mail-in ballots, they can hand-carry them to the County Office. We must exercise our right to vote, and vote by February 16.
