Guest Presentation: Shirley Rollinson (ENMU Religion Program) – The Administration of ENMU is currently considering closing the Religion Program at ENMU. A Program Review committee has put in a report with several inaccuracies, which Shirley Rollinson is contesting. Your prayers are asked. Closing the Program would mean that ENMU would no longer be able to offer a BS or BA degree with a Major in Religion, though the degrees of BAAS (Bachelor of Applied Arts and Science), and BUS (Bachelor of University Studies) with an Emphasis in Religion, and a BA and BA with a Minor in Religion would still be offered. This would represent a significant reduction in educational opportunities for local Youth and Lay Leaders, and for Pastors who wished to pursue further education, as the number and variety of courses offered would also be reduced.

One of the allegations of the Review Committee is that local churches no longer support the Religion Program at ENMU. The best way to counteract this is for there to be 3-5 new Religion Major students registered at ENMU by the Fall semester.

Please, everybody, encourage your Youth and Lay Leaders to enroll as Religion Majors at ENMU, and, please be praying for God's direction and provision.
