Appendix - Appreciation of COVID Nurses

Lemuel Perry brought up an initiative to show our appreciation for the COVID Nurses in our Hospitals. Because of COVID restrictions, Hospital Housekeeping staff are not allowed in COVID rooms – the individual nurses have to do the room cleaning as well as care for their patients. Families are not allowed to visit COVID patients, and the nurses have to work with the families also. In addition, the nurses go through great stress when one of their patients dies. The nurses who have been hardest hit by the COVID pandemic are those working in the Medical, ICU, and ER units.

Lemuel mentioned his thoughts to others, and the project grew, to involve Len Vohs at Rooney-Moon Broadcasting, the Portales Ministerial Alliance, and Albertson's Market. The Portales Ministerial Alliance is going to take care of Roosevelt General Hospital, the CCMA will take care of Plains Regional Medical Center.

The Broadcasting station MIX 107.5 will cover both Hospitals.

MIX 107.5 is going to do a pledge drive, with the goal of raising at least \$4,000 towards providing gift bags and a meal for all COVID nurses in the PRMC Clovis and RGH Portales Hospitals. MIX 107.5 will have a van outside Albertsons during the Pledge Drive, and it would be good to have some members of local churches there also.

There are about 150 nurses who have been impacted by the surge in COVID – in the ER, ICU, and Medical Units, all of which are swamped to overflowing.

As part of the Appreciation, Albertson's will deliver meals and gift bags to each shift of nurses in the ER, ICU, and Medical Units. The gifts bags will each contain a gift card for \$25, and assorted small goodies and thankyou notes and cards from community members and churches. We will also do something for Nurses on other Units.

Sunday School children can get involved by making thank-you cards etc.

The CCMA is going to make a gift of \$200 to the fund.

Churches and individuals can get involved by making financial gifts and by signing greeting cards and notes.

Churches and individuals can call in with pledges during the Pledge Drive. Call 575-763-4649 to make pledges.

Dean Williamson has labels printed for each individual COVID nurse, and has an Excel file of nurses' names which Churches could use.

Any Church can take as many names as they want, and make or buy thank-you notes and cards to personalize for the nurses. There will be a drop box for thank-you cards and notes at New Life Assembly of God, or one can give them to Dean Williamson.

The Ladies of Bethlehem Baptist will assemble the gift bags to take to the nurses.

The meals and gift bags will be delivered to the COVID Units, and gift baskets will be delivered to other units.
