Second Declension Nouns

The Second Declension contains

Masculine nouns, ending in **-ΟΣ**,

Neuter Nouns, ending in **-ΟΝ**,

the Name of Jesus, **Ἰησους**,

and a few Feminine nouns :

ἡ ἔρημος desert

ἡ ὁδος way, road

ἡ παρθενος virgin

Singular Masculine Nouns

Nom. ὁ λογος (the word)

Acc. τον λογον

Gen. του λογου

Dat. τω λογω

ὁ Ἰησους

τον Ἰησουν

του Ἰησου

τω Ἰησου

Neuter Nouns

το ἔργον (the work)

το ἔργον

του ἔργου

τω ἔργω

Plural

Nom. οἱ λογοι

Acc. τους λογους

Gen. των λογων

Dat. τοις λογοις

τα ἔργα

τα ἔργα

των ἔργων

τοις ἔργοις

NOTE :

1. All Nouns ending in **-ΟΝ** are Neuter.
2. Neuter Plural Subjects usually take a singular verb - they behave as if they were singular collective nouns.
